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## Executive Summary

The workshop on "Maximizing Institutional Potential: NIRF Workshop for Academic Success" was a comprehensive event designed to empower educational institutions with strategies and insights to improve their performance and achieve higher rankings in the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF). ## **Workshop Highlights**

### **Understanding NIRF and its Significance**




