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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

This project report, titled "The Effect of Performance Appraisal on Employee Performance at Konkan Specialty Polyproducts Private Limited," explores the impact of performance appraisal systems on employee motivation, job satisfaction, and productivity. Conducted over six weeks, the research examines the appraisal process to identify strengths and areas for improvement that can enhance employee engagement and overall organizational effectiveness.

The report is divided into five sections. The first introduces Konkan Specialty Polyproducts, detailing the company's operations, culture, and competitive environment, and includes a SWOT analysis to evaluate its performance appraisal practices.
