Activity report: Blood Donation Camp at Punarjanma, AHMC, on 10.02.2024

A blood donation camp was hosted at Alva's Punarjanma, on 10.02.2024, in association with the NSS and YRC units of Alva's Institute of Engineering and Technology, Alva's Homoeopathic Medical College and Alva's College of Naturopathy and Yogic Sciences, with the goal of addressing the acute need for blood in local hospitals and medical institutions, encouraging voluntary blood donation, and raising awareness about the life-saving benefits of blood donation. The event was organised in association with Dt. Wenlock Hospital, Mangalore, IRCS-Mangalore, Alva's Rotary Blood Bank, Moodbidri, and the Lions Clubs of Moodbidri. The blood donation camp began at 9:00 AM. The volunteers worked together to set up the donation room, a waiting and resting area for donors, organise the medical equipment, complete the registration process, and distribute donor certificates. Volunteers also kept track of the donors' well-being and provided assistance as needed. The blood donation camp ended at 2:00 PM and a total of 175 units of blood were collected.

Outcome: A total of 175 donors came forward to give blood. The event was successful in promoting awareness about the necessity of blood donation, debunking myths and misconceptions, and fostering a culture of volunteer blood donation in the community. Volunteers gain a sense of civic responsibility, learn to work in groups, practise organisational and time management skills, develop leadership abilities, and develop understanding and compassion.
