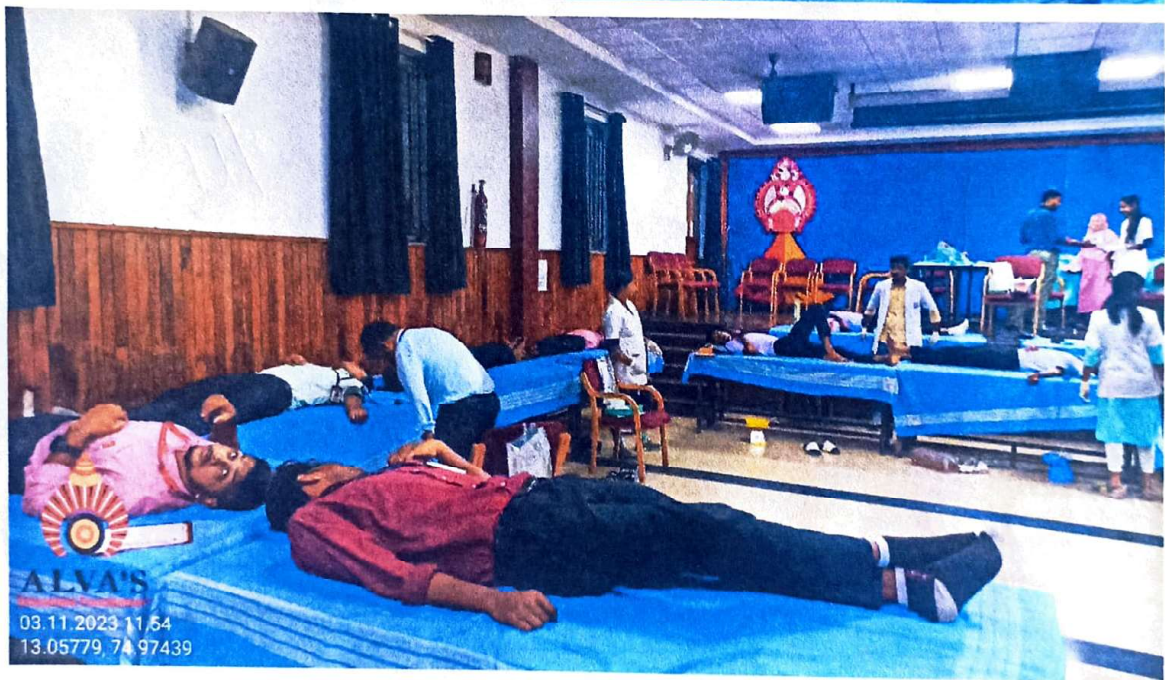
Activity Report: A Mega Blood Donation Camp on 03.11.2023, at Vidyagiri Campus
