Total Quality Management in teaching learning was organized for the faculties and students of Civil Engineering Department on 20 June 2024. Prof and Head of Department, B Durga Prasad Baliga highlighted the importance on Outcome-Based Education (OBE) as an educational approach that prioritizes student learning outcomes over traditional input-based methods. Focusing on what students should know and ensuring that they would be able to course rather than simply the amount of time spent in class or the number of lectures delivered. Evaluating the earlier semester results, and earlier records of the students, Prof. Baliga addressed the students and faculty as below.
