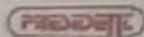



EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Increased competition in today's global markets, the introduction of products with shorter life cycles, and the heightened expectations of customers have forced business enterprises to invest in, and focus attention on, their supply chains. This, together with continuing advances in communications and transportation technologies (for example; mobile communication, Internet, and overnight delivery), has motivated the continuous evolution of the supply chain and of the techniques to manage it effectively.

Furthermore, management uses responsibility accounting as a control device. The aim of responsibility accounting is to help management in achieving organizational goals. It is an invaluable support to modern management. It contributes to the firm's management by providing relevant information on a continuous basis. Responsibility accounting reports are categorized to different levels of responsibility. They start from lowest to highest level of responsibility in the hierarchy. Performance reports usually reflect the budgeted and actual financial results of the related responsibility centres. Management reporting is divided into two types: responsibility reporting and information reporting. Such reports aim to report and inform the executives of how duties are fulfilled in the areas that the reporter is directly responsible and how to motivate them to improve performance.
