The final year and pre final computer students of AIET, under the banner of CMANIX forum, conducted a rural computer education camp successfully From 19/01/2021 to 20/01/2021 at Sri Bramhi DurgaParameshwari Kannada Medium High School, Kamalashile. The Rural Computer Education Camp was inaugurated by Dr.Peter Fernandes, Principal, Alva's Institute of Engineering & Technology, Moodbidri along with Mr.Surendra Shetty, Head Master, Sri Bramhi DurgaParameshwari Kannada Medium High School, Kamalashile. The AIET donated the 5 computer systems to the school and Dr.Peter Fernandes, handover the systems to Head Master during inauguration.



The intention of the camp was to provide some basic knowledge to the eighth and ninth standard students of rural government Kannada medium students. The program was divided into morning and afternoon session. The eighth standard students were targeted in morning and the ninth standard in the afternoon respectively. The various basic components of the computer was shown to the students such as RAM memory, Hard disks, CD/DVD drives,



pen drives, keyboard, mouse and so on. The input unit, the processing unit (CPU) and the output units were discussed in detail.



Soon after some theory session, all the students got the chance to experience to try out some basic computer operations such as opening of an application such as Paint, Notepad, MS Word, Music and Video Players and so on. The basics of mobile technology as well as Internet were covered. Some notes about how to start a computer using power button how to shut down computers were shown.

The camp included only very basic information being shared as the students were very new to computers. The hospitality given by the school teachers were laudable and were very cooperative. The camp allowed mutual benefit both for high school students and for our computer science students as they realized how satisfying is to teach such students and bring about computer awareness in this 21<sup>st</sup> century.
