

President's note



Dr. Mohan Alva

The Alva's World Play Virasat 2013 conference was a bit of a surprise for me. I am still in a state of excitement. One day, I was just sitting around turning down the invitation card for this conference. I was impressed by the sheer size of the program. The question of whether these things went on in just four days still haunts me today. Not just a conference, but a year-long premade, the joy enjoyed by them is not all that it is. In the true sense, when the World Conference is enriched, all the hard-work-as-snow melts into snow and the joys and wonders remain eternal.

Play Alva's ten years ago, we had definite thoughts when we started Alva's Virasat programs 5 years ago. Any tasks are easy to start, difficult to keep up with. Going off target is impossible if left out in the distance. The things that were done, the thoughts that were thought long. It is our desire to advance as long as the sun-moon. That is why I think, think, and come to a clear decision. What if the love of Kannada is just one day? Or what is the benefit of hypocritical love? It is true that the thought-words of Kannada are scattered about. It is necessary for each of the ideas to rise to the top according to the religion of the time. Such is the case with Nadu Nadi. Let the work done in Kannada and the work of Kannada can be accomplished.

But it needs a display format. The nature of the show is never hindered. It was our intention to come to the conference as a limitation of limited scope. In addition, the conference is not just a forum where scholars can sit down and discuss, but the ideas of scholars should be engaging the younger generation. It was our responsibility to carry on the shoulders of the gurus who built Kannada. The work of building Kannada has been done across the world. It is our



job to see and introduce that world. The idea that a comprehensive introduction of Kannada was already possible could be seen as the work of street singers, drummers, folk singers, cult rituals, regional linguistic variations, and so on, to introduce folk forms such as vocation, handicraft and worship at its base. It is thus possible for Anm to be able to prove to the working class that the introduction of Kannada and folklore would be a comprehensive introduction to Kannada-based ideas.

Alvas played concerts in four parallel forums, cultivating, folkloric and student-oriented, concluding that music, agriculture, folklore, and students should be the main focus when it was organized.
