REPORT ON AWARENESS PROGRAMM ON CODE OF CONDUCT

HOD addressed the second year Mechanical Engineering students on 3rd August 2016 about code of conduct among students. The students in College should follow the below mentioned code of conduct.

- 1. Maintain discipline in the campus, wearing of ID cards in the campus is mandatory. Students should come to the college in uniform/ decent and presentable attire.
- 2. Mobile phone usage is prohibited.
- 3. Ragging is a crime. Any student found involved in this act will be punished as per the law.
- The desks and other furniture should not be defaced by writing names and obscene remarks on them or even by drawing on them with pens, knives and other sharp instruments.
- Maintain discipline when you are in the other college, representing for placement processor for participating in the co-curricular/extracurricular activities or for any other reasons.
- 6. Students shall not indulge in any kind of malpractice during Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE) examinations and Semester End Examinations (SEE). If any student found violating this during CIE exams, he/she will be awarded zero marks in CIE and suitable counseling and disciplinary action shall be initiated.
- 7. The student admitted to 1st year B.E/ B.Tech. Shall complete the course within a period of eight academic years from the date of first admission, failing which he/she has to discontinue the course.
- 8. Bunking of classes is strictly prohibited, Minimum attendance of 85% is necessary, A student having shortage of attendance in one or more subjects shall have to repeat the whole semester and such students shall not be permitted to take admission to next higher semester.
- 9. The test shall be answered in Blue Books provided in college with pages serially numbered. If a student remains absent for all the Internal Assessment tests conducted, the Internal Assessment Marks shall be marked as AB for the subject. The student shall undergo an Internship for 8 weeks i.e. starting from the end of 7th semester Examination after availing one week vacation and completing during the initial period of 8th semester. Completion of internship is mandatory; if any student fails to complete internship, he/she will not be eligible for the award of degree.

Development of ethical behavior skills in future engineers is a key competency for engineering schools as ethical behavior is a part of the professional identity and practice of engineers. While engineering educators have somewhat established instructional methods to teach engineering ethics, they still rely heavily on teaching ethical awareness, and pay little attention to how well ethical awareness predicts ethical behavior. However the ability to exercise ethical judgment does not mean that students are ethically educated or likely to behave in an ethical manner. 
Later in the interaction session, he cleared many doubts of the students regarding space station.
