On 16th February 2017, Dr. Nagendra S, addressed the Teaching, Non-teaching, SWO and Warden about Professional Ethics in an inclusive session. He said When we hear the word "ethics," we think we understand what the term means. And as educators, when we're confronted with ethical issues, we generally try our best to act well, ethically. But the difference between being an "ethical" person and following a code of ethics can be very different. Further he added Teaching is a highly challenging and highly rewarding profession. It's also a high-risk one. Think of the attributes we most admire in teachers: a caring demeanor, willingness to go above and beyond time spent in the classroom to help students, an ability to reach children who are disconnected, and the personal knowledge of their students that can help each one find his or her passion.

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#### Ethical principles

The five ethical principles that inform our work as professional life are 1) Autonomy, 2) Prevent Harm, 3) Do Good, 4) Justice, and 5) Fidelity. However, there are some universal ethical principles that apply across all professions, including:

- respect for others
- adherence to the law
- doing good and avoiding harm to others
- accountability.



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

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# REPORT ON AWARENESS PROGRAMM ON CODE OF CONDUCT

Members of the Alva's MBA Program are expected to behave in ways that promote individual, academic and professional development and contribute to a positive environment. Additionally, student behavior reflects upon the brand and reputation of our Program and Institution.

The cods have been delivered to the students on 25/09/2017 by Ramakrishna Chadaga Head of the Department MBA. HOD gave awareness on the following points.

- Students are expected to read notices/circulars displayed on the college notice board.
   Ignorance of not reading any notice/circular displayed shall not be accepted as an excuse for failing to comply with the directions contained in it.
- 2. Students shall behave with dignity and courtesy inside and outside the college.
- 3. Students shall observe strict modesty in dress. All students will be in uniform on all week days except on Saturdays. On Saturdays, boys can wear formal dress (trousers & shirt) and girls can wear salwar-suit, trousers and shirt or kurta. Both boys and girls must not wear t-shirt and tight fit dresses. For girls, sleeveless, deep neck, tight leggings, transparent dresses are strictly forbidden. The dress should be clean, ironed and properly tucked in. Plain black or brown belt should be worn. Fancy designer belts are not allowed.
- Black shoes with socks for boys, and plain black shoes for girls without high heels are permitted.
- 5. Personal grooming is essential for everyone irrespective of gender.

- Teachers should provide an innovative and quality education to pupils.
- Be impartial and discriminative against students.
- Interact with the students in a friendly manner.
- Abide by the rules and regulations of the institution.

- Be responsible and interact positively with parents and other stakeholders in educating the students.



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- Be good counselors and facilitators.
- Teachers should carry out other academic, co-curricular and organizational activities that may be assigned to them from time to time.
- Attend and participate in the meeting, activities called / assigned by the HOD, Principal, and Management.


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away as tears keep them in your hearts so that each heart beat reminds you to reach your dreams", he told students never to hesitate in doing what is right even if you feel the world is against you.




